

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Abstracts may relate to clinical or laboratory research, evidence based practice projects, quality improvement initiatives, or clinical case studies. Abstracts should be free from commercial bias. Promotional abstracts will not be accepted. This is open to all students, residents and fellows in training.

The first author is considered to be the primary author, responsible for the content and integrity of the project. All authors, including primary authors may submit more than one abstract if desired. However, each author can serve as primary author only once. The primary author is expected to present the abstract at the meeting.

**Abstract Submission Deadline:
September 20, 2017 @ Midnight**

Please review the following instructions and adhere to them as you develop your abstract.

Abstracts should not exceed 525 words, excluding title. Author's names and institutions should not be included in the title or abstract. Titles should not exceed 300 characters.

Research and QI projects should address the following areas:

- Purpose
- Relevant background/problem
- Methods
- Results/Data analysis

Implications Case studies should include the following:

- A thorough description of the clinical situation
- Synthesis of relevant literature
- Implications for clinical practice

DO NOT INCLUDE GRAPHS, TABLES OR ILLUSTRATIONS. Abstract presentation should be in the form of Power Point presentation, submitted via email or Google Drive, bring file on USB Drive to the event. Primary author will be the corresponding author and their contact information is needed for our correspondence.

Abstracts will be non-promotional in nature and without commercial bias.
